This is how we stay safe when we use computers:

- I will ask a teacher, or suitable adult, if I want to use the computers/tablets
- I will only use activities that a teacher or suitable adult has told or allowed me to use
- I will take care of computers/tablets and other equipment
- I will ask for help from a teacher or suitable adult if I am not sure what to do, or if I think I have done something wrong
